

Guidelines For Parents / Guardians

- 1. Parents are earnestly requested to co-operate with the school in enforcing regularity and discipline, seeing that their children wear the prescribed uniform, prepare their lessons and take an active interest in the activities of the school.
- 2. Parents should **check the diary everyday** to note homework, other instructions and remarks and sign it promptly. In case of small children, the parents are advised to check the bag of their wards to see if any notice/invitation has been issued
- 3. Any change in the address or telephone numbers should be brought to the notice of the school authority.
- 4. Children, when sick, should not be sent to school.
- 5. Parents are requested not to enter the classrooms to see their wards or teachers during school hours without the permission of the Principal/coordinctor
- 6. They are requested to behave with decorum and respect while talking to the staff members and comply with school rules.
- 7. Any communication made by parents/guardians should be addressed to the Principal/coordinctor and not to the class teachers. Should there be any legitimate complaint, please meet the Principal at once or write in a separate letter addressed to him/her.
- 8. Leave application must be written well in advance in the leave note of the diary by the parents.
- 9. Parents are requested not to apply for leave if it can possibly be avoided except under serious circumstances. They should appreciate that absence during term is not in the best interest of the student. **Leave for 1/2 day should not be asked.** In emergency, Written permission must be taken from the principal and the class teacher.
- 10. Trophy / shield or any momento won for the school must be submitted in the school office.
- 11. If the management observes that the personality development process and education of the pupils is suffering loss in any manner it reserves the right to take any decision for their Welfare and parents are supposed to abide by that.
- 12. The school management reserves all the rights to change school timings.
- 13. There may be rise in fees in future and we expect our parents to accept that.

Rules of Discipline

- 1. The school believes in discipline and in firmness slackness, disobedience and disregard of rules will not be tolerated and any work or action likely to lower the image of the school is regarded as a breach of the school rules.
- 2. During working hours, discipline and silence are to be kept while moving around the premises. Running, playing or shouting inside or around the school building is not allowed.
- 3. Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. The school uniform should be worn on all working days and for all school functions.
- 4. Care must be taken of all school property and any damage caused by a student will have to be made good by the student concerned.
- 5. The school will not be responsible for the loss of valuable belongings of the students as they are not allowed to bring valuable articles to the school such as wrist watch ornaments, calculators, mobiles, laptops etc.
- 6. If a student finds anything that belongs to the school or to some other student, it must be deposited in the school office immediately.
- 7. Shouting, whistling or throwing of anything in school or at anyone is forbidden. Use of foul language will be seriously dealt with.
- 8. Only English should be the language of communication in school while talking with teachers or other students.
- 9. The School reserves the right to add, alter, amend or cancel any of the rules/regulations given in this almanac at any time at its discretion which will be binding on parents / guardians.
- 10. Keep your classroom orderly.
- 11. No early leaves are allowed for student unless medical or genuine reason.
- 12. 75% Attendance is compulsory for the student.

Absence and Withdrawal

Absence

- 1. Students are requested to complete all work missed during the period of their absence.
- 2. No student well be allowed to leave the school campus during the school hours. However in case of any emergency, the parent(s) should come to the school with an application, explaining the reason to take the ward(s). If the Principal is satisfied with the explanation, their ward (s) may be allowed to go after filling in the performa concerned
- 3. No leave of absence is granted except on medical grounds.
- 4. Reported absence without granted leave or unexplained absence for six consecutive working days will result in the student's name being struck off the rolls.
- 5. All students are expected to attend school on the opening day after every vacation.
- 6. Unintimated absence for 3 consecutive working days immediately after a vacation, session or a term renders a student liable to have his / her name struck off the school's roll.
- 7. Every student must have at least 90% attendance to appear in the annual examination Those who fail to fulfil this criterion, will be debarred form the examination. The relaxation in the attendance may be granted subject to the full satisfaction of the Principal on any of the following two grounds.

Medical grounds : In this case they should submit the medical certificate from a competent authority.

Any mis - happening in the family.

Under both the above mentioned conditions, it is the duty of the parents to inform the school well in time.

8. No re-examination will be held for the students Who abstain themselves from withdraval examination.

:: Withdrawal ::

- 1. A clear calender month's notice must be given before a pupil is withdrawn from the school.
- 2. Transfer / Leaving certificate will not be issued until all dues of the school are cleared.
- 3. Fees once paid is not refundable.
- 4. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds
 - a. Disciplinary.
 - b. Unsatisfactory progress in work.
 - c. Detention or repeated detention in a class.

General Rules on Uniform

- 1. The students are expected to wear the prescribed uniform on all working days.
- 2. The uniform should be neat and well-ironed.
- 3. Shoes should be polished.
- 4. Socks should be clean.
- 5. Hair must be oiled everyday and girls are expected to tie their hair with white ribbon or hair band.
- 6. Nails should be trimmed regularly.
- 7. I card is compulsory for student.
- 8. Girls are allowed to use only plain white hair bands.
- 9. The scarf or the mufflers used by the students during winter must be only of maroon colour or as mentioned separately.
- 10. Caps are not allowed to use in the school.
- 11. It is urged that the uniforms should be bought from the shop prescribed by the school to maintain uniformity of quality and design or the uniform must strictly conform to that available at the prescribed shop.
- 12. Every Wednesday & Saturday the students have to wear sports uniform.
- 13. Boys are expected to have proper haircut.
- 14. No gold or costly ornaments are allowed.
- 15. Short leggings are not allowed.
